## ORG DE RAC WESTERN CAPE SAUVIGNON BLANC 2019

VARIETAL - 100% Sauvignon Blanc

VITICULTURE: Our Constantia grape to wine source was of a very low volume due to a very low yield, so we combined it with grapes grown in the McGregor area. The blending of these different wines of origins created a unique challenge and opportunity for our winemakers. This remarkably pleasant Sauvignon Blanc reflects the best attributes from both these origins.

CELLAR: The Constantia Sauvignon Blanc was transported in a refrigerated truck to the Org De Rac farm and processed after a relative short skin contact period. The other component from McGregor was quite a sturdy structured wine with a very fresh appeal. The blend from the two origins shows a well balance wine with a great fruit mouthfeel.

## **ANALYSIS:**

Alc : 13.2% RS : 2.4 g/l pH : 3.2 TA : 5.7 g/l

## WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

COLOUR: Light green, brilliant fresh pale-yellow tones.

NOSE: Lemony towards greenish fig, gooseberry with taints of ripe peach and passion fruit.

PALATE: Fresh and crisp with zesty lemon, strong varietal mouthfeel with lingering tropical fruit flavours.

FOOD PAIRING: Moroccan lemon chicken, seared tuna, escargots with herb butter.
